SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION



August 20, 2022

ONE (1) COUNCILLOR

Nomination of residents of the Town of Middleton as candidates for the Councillor position on Town Council shall be filed at the office of the Returning Officer, Town Hall, 131 Commercial Street, Middleton between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on nomination day which is Tuesday, July 26, 2022, or by appointment only during office hours in the 7 business days preceding nomination day. The Special Election will be held on Saturday, the 20th of August, 2022 and will be conducted by electronic voting.

You have a chance to make a difference and to be a leader in your community. You do not need any special qualifications. What you need is time and a sincere desire to make your community a better place. This, along with your energy and enthusiasm, will give you most of the tools that you will need to be a successful municipal councillor.

FYI...

Throughout summer and fall, assessors from Property Valuation Services Corporation will be out in communities across the province completing property inspections for building permits, appeals, and sales. PVSC assessors may be in the neighborhood taking measurements and pictures of property and structures. Assessors will always be wearing high-visibility vests and have PVSC-issued ID on them.



Partial Property Tax Exemptions

The deadline for applying for partial property tax exemption (up to \$275) for Town residents is July 31. Applicants with a household income up to a maximum of \$23,400 are eligible.
