

## CHAPTER 46

## TOWN OF MIDDLETON

STREET CLOSURE BY-LAW

BE IT RESOLVED that the following described portion of Marshall Street unopened be permanently closed to the public.

"All that portion of Marshall Street which became a public street by virtue of a declaration by the Annapolis County Council in April 1891 being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the easterly boundary of Brooklyn Street 156.00' south of the south boundary of Dominion Atlantic Railway Right-of-way,

THENCE N51°29'30"E parallel to the Dominion Atlantic Railway to the westerly boundary of the Canadian National Railway,

THENCE southeasterly along the westerly boundary of the Canadian National Railway to a point which is 49.5' south of the last mentioned point measured at right angles,

THENCE S51°29'30" to the easterly boundary of Brooklyn Street,

THENCE northerly along the easterly boundary of Brooklyn Street to the Place of Beginning,

Said street being 49.5' wide throughout
