7.3 Adoption of Amended Valley Regional Solid Waste-Resource Management Authority IMSA:

250623.04 It was moved and seconded that Council adopt the amended IMSA for the Valley Regional Solid Waste-Resource Management Authority, which is substantively the same except for minor differences in form, as recommended by the Board of Directors of the Interim Intermunicipal Service Agreement on June 11, 2025, on the condition that the Councils of the other intended parties to the amended Agreement also adopt the Agreement. **Motion carried.**
