Rationale

The following policy is established to ensure that fill generated from Town operations shall be utilized by the Town to the greatest economic advantage.

Policy Statement

- 1) Material consisting principally of clay, gravel and sand, with a minimum amount of top soil, silt, and organic material shall be used by the Town for build-up of Industrial Park lots to enhance marketability.
- 2) Since disposal of surplus material is part of Capital project costs, necessary dozing costs, incurred to ready a disposal site at the Park or to level fill dumped from a project, are to be considered part of the specific project cost.
- 3) If a site is not readily available at the Park, the fill shall be dumped as near as possible to the intended disposal site for later use at the site.
- 4) If it is not possible to dump fill to a disposal site or to stockpile fill near the disposal site, it may be sold at the prevailing commercial supply price.
- 5) Fill containing a high percentage of organics and asphalt shall be disposed of at the Construction Debris Site or any private site conveniently available (whenever possible, high asphalt content shall be separated from fill generated on projects, to salvage fill for Town use).


Previous Policies
