Priorities will be given to programs based in Annapolis County that want to:

- Provide leadership from their organization or support youth leadership in their community
- To encourage organizations to overcome barriers as part of their project such as (accessibility, adaptive or inclusive equipment)
- Address transportation issues through timing of the activity, partnering with organizations that can provide transportation, by providing bus passes to those in need or by other methods
- Funding to increase access or programming at community facilities (not in school programs used solely for students)
- If you are interested in taking advantage of this opportunity, you or your organization will need to fill out an application outlining:
 - Contact information for you or your organization
 - What funding you will need?
 - How you will spend the funds to incorporate youth physical activities?
 - Your leadership plan (Does it involve existing members, youth leadership?)
 - How will you address transportation issues? (timing, partnering, bus passes etc)
 - Will your request increase access or programming at community facilities?
 - Who are your funders?
 - Will your program continue without funding?
